Responsibilities

- Maintain excellent communication with the Healthcare Consultant, Summer Program Director,
 Farm School Program Staff, youth, and families
- Provide care to meet the needs of participants in accordance with The Farm School Healthcare Policy: manage medication administration, medical emergencies, illnesses, in-patient care, and transport to urgent care or hospital facilities.
- Review participant health histories and maintain accurate electronic records via CampDoc, the Farm School's participant management system. This includes: review of Injury/Medical log and review of Medication Administration to assure all necessary information is documented
- Maintain first aid kits, medical supplies, and medication storage and administration areas.
- At youth drop-off collect and organize medications, review relevant health history with youth and families, and answer questions from participants and their families.
- At youth pick-up organize and return all youth medications, share information with families regarding youth health, and answer questions from youth and families.
